Every workplace is different and has unique needs. The guidance provided on these pages will help you to determine the right first aid training for your employees.

As an employer, you should assess your specific workplace and employee needs carefully and make sure your First Aider's training covers all of your identified risks and hazards. Use the table below to gain a basic understanding of the training needed to meet your minimum requirements.

Check the further key considerations and make sure the training your First Aiders receive meets all your identified first aid needs.

FIRST AID SKILLS UPDATE TRAINING Course price £75

Employers are encouraged to ensure their first aiders are competent and maintain their skills throughout the three years in which their certificates are valid. This 3-hour course provides first aiders with an opportunity to practice and update their skills at any time while their first aid certificate is valid.

In the UK, one person suffers a heart attack every two minutes but the majority could be saved if their heart was shocked back into rhythm. You don't even need to be a qualified First Aider. Anyone can attend an AED course with St John Training Services.

AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATION (AED) Course price £75

For each minute that passes without defibrillation after the heart stops, the casualty's chance of survival falls by about 10%. Defibrillators are very simple to operate and no previous first aid training is required. This course gives people the confidence to act quickly and effectively in an emergency.

Crucially, this course will teach your defibrillator operators how to perform effective CPR.

MOVING AND HANDLING PRINCIPLES Course price £80

Working in awkward positions, lifting heavy weights incorrectly, as well as carrying a heavy load are cited as the main activities for causing work-related musculoskeletal disorders such as back pain.

The Manual Handling Regulations place a duty on every employer and employee to reduce potential injury (and its associated costs to a business) from moving and handling operations.

We recommend that all employers consider training in moving and handling as part of each new employee's induction.

This course covers how to move objects safely, so that manual handling risks are reduced. Anatomy and physiology are used to raise back awareness and promote good practice in moving objects safely.

- Relevant Health & Safety information
- Spinal anatomy, relevant structure and function
- Causes of back pain
- Risk assessment
- Base positions and movements leading to more complex moves including moving and lifting objects and people (if appropriate)

Certification

Students are awarded a certificate of attendance upon completion of the course valid for 3 years. This course corresponds with NVQ learning outcomes at level 2.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Our aim is to make it as easy as possible to learn First Aid and related subjects with St John Training Services Guernsey. The following conditions are therefore intended to be as simple as possible to meet your training needs.

- Bookings may be made by email, letter or telephone. A booking confirmation and invoice will be sent out once the place(s)
 is/are reserved on a course. If courses/examinations are held outside the island of Guernsey, any expenses incurred such
 as payment for extra hours incurred by the nature of travel, travel costs and refreshments will be charged in addition to
 the standard course fee.
- 2. Payment should be made at least 2 weeks prior to the course start date.
- 3. CANCELLATION/NON-ATTENDANCE. All cancellations must be made in writing. The FULL course fee will be levied in respect of any cancellations made less than 14 days prior to commencement of the course. A fee of 50% will be levied for cancellations made between 14 and 21 days prior to commencement. A substitute delegate can be named at any time. Non-attendance on the day will attract the full course fee.
- 4. If a student arrives late for a course, or is absent from any session, we reserve the right to refuse or accept him/her for training if we feel insufficient knowledge or skills can be gained in the time remaining. In all such cases, the full course fee remains payable.
- 5. St John Training Services Guernsey reserves the right to cancel a course up to 2 weeks in advance of the start date if numbers booked make the course impractical to hold. In such circumstances, as much notice as possible will be given and an offer made of a free transfer to another course date or a full refund of fees paid.
- 6. To be eligible to attend a two-day requalification course, candidates must be in possession of a valid First Aid at Work certificate issued by an HSE approved provider which is current on the last day of the requalification course.

What if my course is relocated, rescheduled or cancelled by St John Training Services Guernsey?

We make every effort to avoid this happening, but occasionally it is necessary. This is why it is vitally important for us to have your current telephone number, or email address, so that we are able to notify you as soon as possible.
